NOTES of a Special Meeting of the Parish Council held at 7.00pm on 8 February 2012 at the home of the Chairman

Present: Cllr G Smailes (Chairman), Cllrs. McKenzie, Parr, Wilkinson and Martin Rae, Parish Clerk

The meeting, specifically of Kirby Hill Parish Councillors, was called to discuss the various quotations for the back-filling of the well shaft with gravel/hardcore plus concrete cap at level of collapse.....

Quotes submitted included A J Hawkridge £1385+VAT (whole job)
G Lumsden £2104 (loose gravel) NO VAT recoverable
£2370 (bagged gravel) NO VAT recoverable
Own purchase*of gravel+contract labour £1707+VAT (loose gravel)
" " " " £2091+VAT (bagged ")
* either Shire Aggregates or Brown/Potter

Own purchase of gravel from Brown/Potter in cement mixer
Plus contract labour £1540+VAT

Cllr Wilkinson proposed acceptance of the Hawkridge quote, seconded by Cllr Parr and unanimously agreed.

The clerk was asked to contact Graham Hawkridge and the providers of the unsuccessful quotes. **ACTION CLERK**

The clerk was asked to contact the stone mason, J Maloney to discuss options for the well cover – from doing nothing further (and grassing over the shaft top) to the previously agreed proposal to re-instate the stone cover as it was pre-accident. At the very least Mr Maloney would be owed for the work he had already done and for the stone he had had cut. Proposals would then be discussed at the Parish Council meeting on 6 March.
