MINUTES of a special planning meeting to discuss application 18/05293/OUTMAJ (Gladman)
6 February 2019 7.00pm Coronation Hall

PRESENT: Cllr Ken Lawson (Chairman), Cllrs Merson, Smailes, Wilkinson and Martin Rae (Clerk)

APOLOGIES: Cllrs Helliwell and Hick. Cllr Lister's prejudicial interest ruled out his attendance.

The council had been asked to submit its response to the application by 11 February and the clerk had distributed to councillors, prior to the meeting, a draft submission for discussion.

This comprised an objection to the application on the following grounds:- Over-development and Unsustainable growth; Site not allocated in the Local Plan; Convergence of settlements and Inadequate sewerage infrastructure. It also registered the parish council's concern about the unsatisfactory pre-application consultation process.

It was unanimously agreed to submit the draft, with a couple of amendments, to HBC Planning as the council's response.
