MINUTES of the parish council meeting held at 7.00pm 13 January 2020, in the Coronation Hall, Milby (Notice having been given).

PRESENT: Cllrs Lawson (Chairman), Helliwell, Hick, Lister, Smailes, Widdows and Martin Rae, parish clerk.

1. APOLOGIES for absence: Cllrs Merson and Wilkinson, DCllr Brown and PC Jan Powell

2. CODE OF CONDUCT/DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS: none

3. MINUTES of the meeting of 11 November, having been distributed previously, were accepted as a true record. Proposed by Cllr Helliwell and seconded by Cllr Hick. Duly signed by chairman.

Matters Arising - re 5b) The clerk had received no suggestions of items for inclusion in the 22 January Annual Parishes Meeting to be held at Whixley. Cllr Lawson agreed to attend the meeting if Cllr Merson was unable to go.

4. FINANCE

The Clerk reported:

- a) Balance at 13 January 2020 **£4,957.30**
- b) Coronation Hall room hire **£16.00 payment agreed**
- c) HMRC PAYE for Oct/Nov/Dec **£97.38 payment agreed**
- d) AA Foster grass cutting 2nd half yr **£355.00 paid**

5. CORRESPONDENCE

- a) **HBC Elections Office** – 2020 Register of Electors. Clerk had queried why this did not include Hockley Croft. Awaiting response. Number of electors in the five parishes is 542, down from 551 last year.
- b) **HBC CIL Consultation** New consultation (until 31 January) regarding modifications to CIL following Autumn 2019 consultation. Clerk had looked briefly at this and considered nothing of relevance to parish but had passed details of consultation to councillors. (CIL – Community Infrastructure Levy)

6. COUNCILLORS' REPORTS & MEETINGS

- a) **HBC** – No report.
- b) **NYCC** – No report.
- c) **SNG** – next meeting 20 February 2020. PC Jan Powell had produced a report for the meeting and this had been copied to all councillors.
- d) **JPC** Minutes of 5 December meeting not yet distributed.

7. ONGOING AND OTHER MATTERS – UPDATES

- a) **Public footpaths** – Diversion Orders for footpaths at Priory Meadows, Kirby Hill. (Footpaths 15.67/2/1 and 15.67/3/1) Consultation. Cllrs had no comments to make on the diversions, which would result in the former footpaths now traversing the new development by means of the pavements and roadways.
The clerk agreed to contact NYCC Highways about the state of the road surface in St John's Walk caused by the Priory Meadows construction traffic. **ACTION CLERK**
- b) **£106 monies and commuted sums** - The clerk reported that the £176 on the parish balance sheet should have been spent by 2019 and that he had requested an extension.
- c) **Car Parking issues, Leeming Lane** Cllr Hick had hoped that a representative of the local police would be at the meeting. The clerk agreed to raise the issue with NYCC Highways **ACTION CLERK**
- d) **Milby Island** the clerk reported that Cllr Merson had for several years voluntarily provided the dog waste bin facility, emptying it into private waste bins, sometimes twice a week. Cllrs agreed that the clerk should once again request an 'official' bin from HBC for the Ure bridge entrance to the Milby Island footpath. A previous request had been refused but the path was now more heavily used and would become more so following the completion of all the new developments close to the walk. Cllrs further agreed that the parish council would, if necessary, be prepared to pay for the emptying of a bin should HBC again refuse. **ACTION CLERK**
